WIND ENERGY

India's wind energy sector is led by the indigenous wind power industry and has shown consistent progress. The expansion of the wind industry has resulted in a strong ecosystem, project operation capabilities, and a manufacturing base of about 18000MW per annum. The country currently has the fourth-highest wind-installed capacity in the world.

India has a liberal Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) policy, allowing 100% FDI under the automatic route in various sectors.

The Maha Kumbh Mela (the festival of the sacred pitcher) is the world's largest public gathering and collective act of faith. This sacred festival embodies humanity's enduring pursuit of spiritual liberation, reflecting the belief in freedom from the cycle of birth, death, and rebirth.

The Kumbh Mela is an event that intrinsically encapsulates the science of astronomy, astrology, spirituality, ritualistic traditions, and socio-cultural customs and practices, making it extremely rich in knowledge.

The Maha Kumbh Mela 2025 began on January 13 and is set to continue until February 26, with an expected participation of over 450 million people.
